Our Monte Sereno vineyard of four and a quarter acres was planted in 2001 and represents not only the first Cabernet Sauvignon produced from this vineyard, but also the very first Cabernet to be bottled at Brassfield Estate Winery. This wine exudes exceptional varietal character, and is a classic example of everything expected in a world-class Cabernet Sauvignon. Dark fruits of blackberry and dried currants predominate while subtle elements of earth, eucalyptus, leather and black olive add to this harmoniously orchestrated feast for the senses.
