

# 2005 Brassfield Estate Petite Sirah High Valley Appellation

Volcano Ridge vineyard is located on the steep slopes of an extinct cinder cone at 2,200 feet above sea level. The pure volcanic soils are extremely well-drained and are ideal for vine stress and restricting crop yields. This first crop off this new third leaf vineyard produced a wine of intense concentrated and complex aromas, deep hues, and opulent fruit flavors.
