## 2017 Pinot Gris

A perfumed nose reminiscent of a flower garden is filled with roses, gardenias, lemon verbena, and honeysuckle. This savory wine unfolds to reveal a bright and crisp palette filled with green apple, melon, Asian pear, and sourdough bread. Our Pinot Gris has a lengthy mineral-laden finish with enough structure to make it a wine worth aging.



## 2017 Sauvignon Blanc

This is the most unique and distinctive Sauvignon Blanc Brassfield has ever produced. It has a style all its own with a richness and depth not found in typical California Sauvignon Blancs. Its nose is a complex mix of lime zest, Mandarin orange, melon, peppery spice, and cut grass. Pear, grapefruit, and guava provide a mouth-filling injection of ripe fruitiness. The wine's pale straw color is indicative of the winemaking methods and hints of the lengthy finish that is a synergy between extracted grapes, subtle oak, and delicate minerality.



## 2015 Pinot Noir

More film noir than action movie, our Pinot Noir starts the show with deep rooted earthy notes and taut pinot power. As the plot thickens, rich strawberry compote confronts blackberry cola, and flirts with spicy cedar. Let this one unfold in your glass and it will have you coming back to find something new each time. Creamy cheese and thick sauces deepen the understanding.



## 2014 Eruption

53% Malbec, 16% Syrah, 15% Zinfandel,  
9% Petite Sirah, and 7% Mourvèdre.

High Valley Appellation

A full bodied Rhone-style blend with an unmistakable California accent. This wine is brimming with rich blackberry, raspberry, and plum notes. Ripe fruit reminiscent of blueberry pie is balanced by an underpinning of baking spices. The thick composition of this blend is complemented by a core of volcanic tannins and is drawn out to a lengthy finish by subtle minerality. Currently accessible, but age worthy for at least a decade.

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
